Weigh In

- A-Frame set up
- Scales set up
- Computer program set up
- Event will consist of four classes:
 1. Dolphin
 2. Wahoo
 3. Tuna
 4. Marlin
- Rules:
 1. All sheets for each class will be turned in to the weigh master before weighting begins.
 2. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place will be determined by closest weight to the tenth of a pound.
 3. In case of a tie, another weight will happen.
- Calcutta per class payout:
 - 1st place, 50% of prize money
 - 2nd place, 30% of prize money
 - 3rd place, 20% of prize money
